80 Degrees and Sunny

The projects that have been sitting idle due to the winter weather have been brought back to life by a string of 80 degree sunshine filled days.

The painting of the elevated water tower on the corner of Zschokke Street and 13th Street has been completed. The communication towers will be replaced and the ground equipment moved. The tank has been refilled but cannot be placed back in service until the system which monitors the water level in

the tank is reinstalled. The Tot Lot playground will require quite a lot of work yet to get it ready for visitors.

Work has also resumed on the reconstruction project on Iberg Road. For the past two weeks Cox and Sons Contractors have been installing storm sewers and have completed the northern portion of the underground storm sewer. This work will continue with construction scheduled to be completed by summer's end.

If you have had the need to drive down Broadway in the past two weeks you could not have helped but notice that Christ Bros, IDOT's contractor for the resurfacing project, are also back to work. They have milled the old surface and replaced it with a new asphalt service. While this is not a city run or financed project, the new smoother roadway through the center of town will be much appreciated once the construction is completed.
