Main & Walnut Resurfacing

The Main Street and Walnut Street resurfacing project, scheduled to begin the week of July 26th, finally was in full swing this week.

As temperatures hovered near 100 degrees all week crews removed the old surface on Main Street from Washington Street to Poplar Street and Thursday began placing the new surface in that area.

Walnut Street from Broadway, south to the end of the street, is also being resurfaced as part of this project. Rooter's American Maintenance of Beckemeyer, Illinois began this phase of the project last week with the relocation of the traffic signal sensors at the corner of Walnut Street and Broadway.

During this time parking restrictions have been in place along both Main Street and Walnut Street. We thank the residents and businesses along the route for their patience.

Rooter's submitted the winning bid for this project in the amount of \$192,860.86.
