Concrete Poured this Week



When it's dry they pour, concrete that is. This week the Public Works Department saw concrete being poured at three of the on-going projects.

On Wednesday, both Cox and Sons and Baxmeyer Construction were pouring concrete on the Iberg Road Construction and the Koepfli Lane Extension projects.

On Thursday Mettler Construction poured concrete on the parking lot at the corner of Main Street and Pine Street as part of the Main Street parking lots project. This project, while only started on Monday, July 12th, is expected to be completed by the end of the month.



Upcoming Projects

A pre-construction meeting was held with Rooter's American Maintenance out of Beckemeyer, the winning bidder for the Walnut Street and Main Street Resurfacing Project. This project is expected to begin July 26th and be completed by August 13th.

A pre-bid meeting was held on July 12th for the upcoming Highland Dam Construction. This project will build two earthen dams to create a water source away from Silver Lake for livestock. This bid will open on July 27th at 10:00am at City Hall.
