



## Project Updates

### IBERG ROAD PROJECT AWARDED—

The City Council, at their meeting on August 19th, awarded a contract to Keller Construction of Glen Carbon, Illinois for the construction of the final phase of the northeast peripheral route, which will extend Iberg Road from Michael Road to Troxler Avenue.

Keller was the low bidder with a bid of \$6,570,061.42. A total of nine bids were received for this project, ranging from the winning low bid to a high of \$8,892,738.28.

A preconstruction meeting will be held next week, and groundbreaking is scheduled for August 29th.

This project is expected to be completed in 2015.

### HEMLOCK / US 40 INTERSECTION—

This project has suffered a delay in completion due to the relocation of some utility lines in the area. These lines are scheduled to be moved and the project should be back underway in the next couple of weeks.



## Clear Well Tank

## Maintenance

This past weekend, Midco Diving & Marine Services of Rapid City, South Dakota performed an inspection and maintenance of the clear well at the water treatment plant. The EPA recommends that this scheduled inspection be performed every 5 years.

Prior to the dive, pumping was suspended. The diver, wearing a totally enclosed dry suit, and the equipment are disinfected before entering the tank. The tank was cleaned and vacuumed during the inspection. After completion the water was completely changed and pumping was resumed.
