Iberg Road Update

Now that the bridge cones are in place, the contractor has started the installation of the storm sewer. Storm sewer work will continue throughout the winter.

The manhole you see here is one of 127 different manholes and inlets that will be installed on the project. Manholes will range in size from 24" to 96" diameter.



This is a photograph of Keller construction workers setting one of two 6' x 4' box culvert on the jobsite.

Each section weighs 18,000 pounds. Only 3 sections can be hauled per tractor trailer.

This is a photo of the riprap near one of the recently installed box culverts.

The riprap will help prevent erosion. A total of 2,260 tons will be placed during this job.
