Troxler Avenue Widening

Bids for the Troxler Avenue Widening project were opened at 10:00am on Wednesday January 30 at City Hall. There were nine bidders who submitted bids that ranged from a low of \$850,363.84 to a high of \$1,018,720.80.

At their meeting on Monday, February 4th the City Council approved Director Gillespie's recommendation to accept the low bid and to award the project to Petroff Trucking Company, Inc. of Collinsville, Illinois.

A pre-construction was held on Thursday. The start date for this project is Monday, February 18 and is expected to be completed by June 14th.



The Troxler Avenue widening project will add an additional lane down the entire stretch of roadway from Route 160 to Route 140 /143, giving residents of Augusta Estates and traffic for the new hospital a turn lane. Curbs and gutters along Troxler Avenue are a part of the widening. A multi-use path, similar to the path along Frank Watson Parkway, will be constructed on the south side of Troxler Avenue along the front of the hospital property to the corner of Troxler Avenue and Route 160, then will turn south and run along the west side of Route 160 along the hospital property. This path will eventually run along the entire south side of Troxler Avenue to Route 40 /143.
