Happy Fiscal New Year!!

The first of May is the beginning of a new fiscal year for the City of Highland. At the meeting on April 16th, the council approved the new budget for the coming year. The city as a whole had a budget of \$39,619,929. Of that amount the Public Works Department has been allotted \$5,706,217. The divisions will use those funds for operating expenses, personnel costs, and the purchase or construction of larger items and projects.

In the coming month we will be highlighting each division and get an idea of what they have on tap for the new budget year.

Public Works Week will be celebrated nationally this year May 19—26. The week seeks to raise the public's awareness of public works issues and to increase confidence in public works employees who are dedicated to improving the quality of life for present and future generations. The theme this year, "Because of Public Works. . ." is about the quality of life brought to communities around the world.
