Fall Projects

PINE STREET WATER LINE

Still on schedule to be completed before the end of the year is the replacement of some water main on Pine Street.

Water and Sewer Division workers will be removing an old 2" cast iron line and replace it with a new 6" main. The work will be done on Pine Street between 13th Street and 17th Street.

The old 2" line has been repaired on several occasions. The new line and service connections should provide residents in the area with better water quality and more consistent service.

Weather permitting, work should be starting soon and complete before the end of the year.

BROADWAY SIDEWALK EXTENSION

Work on the Broadway Sidewalk Extension slowed this week due to weather. Workers have removed existing driveways and are now working to install storm sewers.

This project will be completed by early November.

STREET DEPARTMENT OIL & CHIP

In September the Street & Alley Division spent several days working to place new oil and chip surfaces on several streets. The project is not yet complete as the weather has been a factor in completing some alleyways yet to be resurfaced. Monday, October 24th should be the last day of work for this project, weather permitting.

LATZER LIBRARY PARKING LOT CONSTRUCTION

Bid documents and plans are currently available at the Public Works office for construction of a parking lot located just to the east of the Latzer Library.

In addition to the parking lot project, a landscaping project for the library is also currently out for bid. Those bidding documents are available at Oates Associates in Collinsville.

Both bids will be publicly opened and read at City Hall on Tuesday November 1, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.
