Qualifications include: Bachelor's degree in MIS or related field; 10+ years of progressive IT experience including experience managing multiple projects and cross platform information systems; 5-10 years supervisory experience; exposure to working with MS Windows Environments, along with installation, maintenance, support to TCP/IP networks; and professional certifications such as Project Management Professional, Microsoft Certified Profession, Cisco CCNA/CCNP, Comptia Network+, and Security+.
