Subject: Amending Ordinance: Section 46-37. Boats and Boating

I am formally requesting the Highland Silver Lake Advisory Commission approve my recommendation to amend the aforementioned ordinance pertaining to non-motorized watercraft; i.e. canoes and kayaks, to be exempt from providing proof of insurance. However, I do recommend a waiver be required in lieu of the insurance.

The current ordinance requires all watercraft to carry the following:

- \$100,000 of personal injury and death limits for one person
- \$300,000 for personal injury and death limits for all claims
- \$25,000 property damage coverage

In addition, I would like to include a tier for daily and/or weekend passes for reason previously discussed; i.e. numerous requests, potential additional revenue. Furthermore, it allows additional access for people to utilize the lake which is part of my overall comprehensive plan.

Please keep in mind that should the commission agree, the attorney and city council will cast the final decision.
