UNAPPROVED

Meeting was called to order by Randy Ammann at 7:00pm. Members present were Randy Ammann, Gary Pugh, Sally Raeber, Bill Ambuehl, and Dave Frey. Natural Resource Manager Ryan Hummert was also present.

Randy Ammann made a motion to approve the previous meetings minutes and Gary Pugh seconded.

Ryan Hummert, Natural Resource Manager, informed the commission of the atrazine money awarded to the city with the intent to utilize the money for future lake projects. He advised the commission that more information would be made available to them as it was directed from City Hall. Ryan also passed on to the commission the city was awarded \$37,400 in a conservation grant program in order to perform 400-500' of rip rap along the Old City Lake below the water plant.

Gary Pugh and Ryan Hummert discussed with the commission concerning dropping cover for fish habitat in the lake. It was recommended that we mark some of the areas and leave some of the cover areas unmarked as to not overfish all of them. Randy Ammann indicated this would greatly benefit the fishery in Silver Lake. The city will discuss purchasing the material for the volunteers to be used such as pvc pipe and concrete materials. More information will be available in the coming months concerning the drop.

The commission reviewed Mark Rosen's memo regarding the need for action regarding the erosion and sediment load on the north end of the lake. Sally Raeber indicated the need for the City to act quickly and develop a plan to begin implementing on the lake. The commission indicated as a whole "it's the only water the city has, we need to protect it and make sure it's here in the future."

Randy Amman made a motion to adjourn at 7:25. Dave Frey seconded the motion.
