- Plans are in place for **Andrea Garson**, a master gardener who maintained the Plaza Park planter boxes this year, to plant the flower pots around the Square next year.
- The idea of reviving the **Spring Bloom Festival** remains tabled at this time.
- Discussion was held regarding the Boy Scouts possibly hosting a clean-up day at Silver Lake Park.
- The Commission plans to revisit the idea of a **Community Tree Program**.
- The **Pioneer Newspaper** may be used as a tool to distribute tree-related information to the public.

New Business:

- Discussed several ways to improve community outreach and public education, including using the **Pioneer Newspaper** and the **Highland Happenings App**.
- Consideration was given to creating a **Community Christmas Tree** for the public to help decorate.
- Tree planting recommendations for the Square include:
 - o Zelkova Green Vase, 2" B&B
 - o Tulip 'Emerald City', #15 Gallon (great fall color)
 - o Nyssa Sylvatica 'Tupelo Black Gum', 2" B&B (no gum balls, exceptional color)
- The **evergreen on the southeast corner** of the Square will need to be replaced.
- **Jim Miller** will be asked to inspect the large tree on the **northeast corner** of the Square to determine if the existing split can be repaired.
- Plans are in place to remove **two trees at the cemetery** and replace them with **bald cypress** trees to match the existing plantings.
- The **arborvitae at the library** will be transplanted behind the backstop at the **Optimist** Field in Glik Park.
